Science:	<p>Topic: Rocks and Soil</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Looking at and describing different rocks and soil (metaphoric, sedimentary and igneous). • To compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their simple physical properties • To describe in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rocks • To recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter • To learn about abrasion and erosion
