



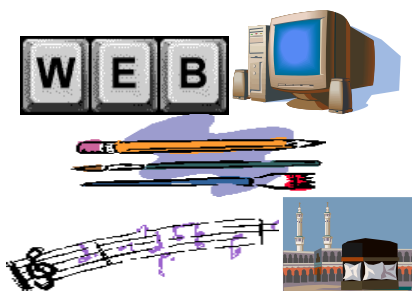


<p>Writing</p> 	<p>Purpose of the writing: Myths and Legends/Writing to Entertain</p> <p>We will be learning:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To understand the purpose of a Myths and Legends story • To identify the language features of mythical story • To understand the impact different language can have on the reader. • To begin to apply 'writing for impact' to their own stories.
<p>Reading and Phonics</p> 	<p>We will be...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading a range of key words on sight. • Using our knowledge of phonics to decode and blend unfamiliar words. • To be able to summarise longer pieces of writing, starting with a page and ending with a chapter. • To be able to make inferences from a picture and sentences. • To answer test type questions.
<p>Numeracy</p> 	<p>We are learning about...</p> <p>Focus:</p> <p><u>Division</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To be able to use the grouping method to divide numbers. • To be able to use the formal division method to divide numbers. • To begin to solve problems using division. <p><u>Money</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To understand how to make an amount using different coins. • To be able to convert pence's to pounds. • To add money using the column method • To be able to find change using subtraction. • To be able to solve reasoning problems using their knowledge of money.
<p>Science</p> 	<p>Topic: Plants</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To be able to label and describe the different functions of a plant. • To identify the different conditions that plants need to grow. • To make sensible predictions based on previous knowledge of plants. • To plan and conduct a fair test on how plants grow.

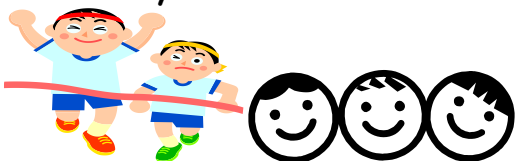
RE and Collective Worship
