


Year 2 Overview for Autumn 1



Reading:

Reading common exception words on sight and apply them in writing.
Using phonic knowledge to support reading (segmenting and blending)
Reading a range of fiction and non-fiction text and answering questions from it, identifying characters, setting and the plot
Thinking of their own questions from the text.
Retelling familiar stories

Please bring your book bag to school everyday!

Science: This half term we will be looking at Healthy Living. Within the topic we will find out about the importance of exercise, healthy food and food groups.

Learning for Life:

Topic: Fire and Light
The children will study London looking at life now and life in the past. They will look at The Great Fire of London and famous people that lived within that period.
They will learn how to locate cities on a map.

RE: Being respectful of suffering and Sharing and giving.
Collective Worship- Honesty

PE:

We have PE every Tuesday and Wednesday morning. The children have some lessons outside. The children need trainers and track suit bottoms, especially now that the weather is getting colder.

Writing:

This half term - children will be looking at 2 different genres.

Poetry - Poetry about the movement of fire, fireworks (sound / colour / movement), Patterns on the page that will include shape poems.

Traditional stories : The Owl Who was Afraid of the Dark, Can't you Sleep Little Bear, Three Little Pigs, Rama and Sita and nativity stories (Linked to RE).

We will be concentrating on:

- Using capital letters and full stops and accurate letter formation
- Using powerful adjectives to make our writing more interesting
- Extending sentences using 'and' and 'because'
- Simple and compound sentences
- Using story language
- Noun phrases

Numeracy:

We will introduce:

- Reading and writing numerals up to 100 in numerals and words
 - Ordering numbers up to 100
 - Counting forwards in 2s, 5s, and 10s
 - Counting backwards in 2s, 5s and 10s
 - Understanding place value
 - Addition and subtraction
 - Money-recognising and using coins, finding change, addition and subtraction.
 - Multiplication and division
- All work will involve problem solving.
