- Times tables (2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 6x, 8x, 10x)

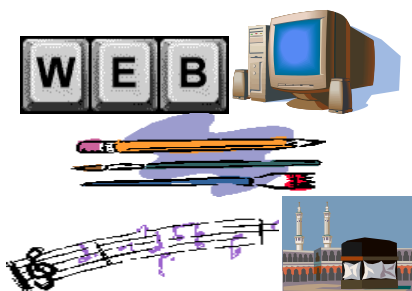
Science

Topic- Stone Age

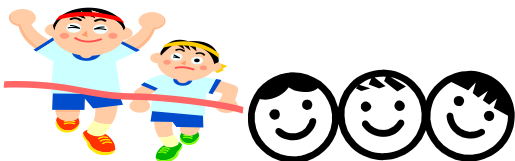
Learning through: History, Geography, Music, Art and Design
