Reading:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Our text will focus on our topic of Migration. We will be reading the text 'Refugee Boy.' We will focus on word meaning to build on our vocabulary skills. A focus of the assessment strands will be taught which focuses on finding words and/or phrases and locating evidence from a text.
Writing:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will be focusing on narrative writing linked to our non-core topic of Migration. Our Writing will include: a letter of complaint, diary entry and writing a narrative. Grammar Focus: We will continue looking at punctuation, using standard English, modal verbs and correct verb tenses.
Maths:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This term we will be revising the topics taught in Maths such as, place value, the four operations, fractions, percentages, and measurement. To be able to solve reasoning problems linked to these topics.
Science:	<p>Animals including humans</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will be looking at the impact of diet, exercise, and lifestyle on the body. Describe the ways in which nutrients and water are transported.
RE:	<p>The dispositions we will be looking at this term are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Expressing Joy Appreciating Beauty We will be exploring these topics by looking at Christianity, Islam, Judaism and Sikhism.
Non-Core:	<p>We will be starting our new topic of Migration which will be learnt through Geography and Music.</p> <p>We will focus on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Comparing London to Addis Ababa with a focus on topography, climate, vegetation, and soil. Explore human geography such as multiculturalism. Describe and understand key aspects of earthquakes (physical geography in Ethiopia). Understand how earthquakes caused people to migrate.
